

What can I apply for?

You can apply for:-

- an educational course or skills training that will help you improve your chances of getting a job
- financial support for other expenses, including living expenses, to help you undertake a course of training
- equipment, books or materials required to get a job

Please note that we are unable to fund driving lessons however we can fund Long Goods Vehicle (LGV) and Passenger Carrying Vehicle (PCV) courses would be eligible.

Maryhill Housing will pay the supplier or the equipment or education establishment directly.

Who decides if I get a bursary?

There are a limited number of bursaries available. Applications will be assessed against set criteria by Maryhill Housing employees. Decisions on applications will be made at the end of each month and you will receive notice of your application outcome after this date.

You can also apply now for a bursary which you need anytime over the next 6 months. If unsuccessful, you can also re-apply for a Bursary next year.

Helpful Information

What is a Maryhill Housing Bursary?

It is a grant that Maryhill residents can apply for to support them to achieve their educational goals and help them on the career path they wish to undertake.

Who Can Apply?

- Applicants must be registered living in a Maryhill Housing property
- Maximum 2 applications per eligible household per year
- Maximum of one bursary per person per year

When Can I Apply?

The application process is open from 20 Sept 2017 to 31 March 2017. However, the earlier you apply, the greater your chances of success.

How much can be applied for?

We intend to give bursaries of varying amounts for different courses and/ or the purchase of equipment, books and materials.

Up to £1,000 For Higher Education / Further Education courses (both full time and part time courses up to degree level)

Up to £750 For skills specific training (e.g. Construction Skills Certification Scheme -CSCS card, Health & Safety course, Food Hygiene, Forklift Truck training etc.)

Up to £500 For purchase of equipment, books and/ or materials (e.g. chef's utensils, hairdressers college kit etc.) travel and other costs

The above are maximum amounts. You can apply for any amount up to the maximum.
